Some statistics:
388 funded projects (14% success),
84 teams (50% of leaders under 40)
PI's: 219 male/169 female, 12 foreigners
755 students (13 foreign)
853 PhD students (104 foreign)
222 postdocs (31 foreign)

• Objective:

establishment of a new Centre of Excellence (or the upgrading of an existing one)

- Teaming process between:
 - an institution of research and innovation excellence (public or private) or a consortium of such institutions and

 the participant organisation from a low performing Member State

 (Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia)

Foundation for Polish Science

- Call announced Dec 2013
- Deadline 17 Sep 2014
- Who can apply:

for example a national or regional authority, or a research agency at national or regional level the presence of a local partner research institution in stake

Proposal:

clear alignment and complementarity with the relevant Smart Specialisation Strategies of the Member State or region from which the applicant is coming

the long-term science and innovation strategy of the future Centre (organisation profile, good management...)

- First Stage:

 Proposals (2014)
 12 months award for business plans (2015)
 (up to 0,5 M Euros)
- Competition of Business plans (2016)
 7 years award for teaming (2017)
 (up to 20 M Euros)

Objective:

 Creation of some world class research centers in Poland under supervision of International Research Boards in partnership with an excellent centers from another country
 Creation of competitive research environment in Poland
 Complementarity to Teaming of Excellence

 (FNP will enter writing proposals to ToE solely in line with IRA)

- Mid 2014 announcement of IRA by FNP
- End 2014 deadlines
- Mid 2015 decisions on 2-3 awards and 2nd call
- Mid 2016 decisions on 2-3 awards

Foundation for Polish Science

Funding for each IRA (provisional, subject to PO IR):

 1M PLN/year/group (up to 25)
 Some other costs (up to 10 M PLN)
 Supplements subject to mid-term evaluation results)

 Access to infrastructure and open recruitment of staff required





Virtual Institute



Foundation for Polish Science

Operational Program
 Objective:

 Establishment of a centre based on competitive and international standard of research focused on commercialization of results

 Operate on existing infrastructure and in partnership with existing research centres or universities





Virtual Institute



 Provisional Timetable at FNP

 2nd half of 2014 – call for interest
 Early 2015 etablishment of research agenda and International R & D Board
 2015 first calls for independent positions

Funding
 Ca. 1M PLN/year/group





Call for Twinning



Foundation for Polish Science

Call announced – 2 July 2014
Deadline – 2 Dec 2014

Objective:

strengthening a defined field of research in a particular knowledge institution

 creating a link between this institution and at least two internationally-leading research institutions in other Member States





Call for Twinning

Foundation for Polish Science

• Proposal:

- the scientific strategy for stepping up and stimulating:
 - scientific excellence and innovation capacity in a defined area of research
 - the scientific quality of the partners involved in the twinning exercise
- contribution to the overall Smart Specialization Strategy
- set of measures to be supported:
 - E.g. short term staff exchanges; expert visits or virtual training; workshops; conferences; organization of joint summer schools; dissemination, etc



Call for Twinning

FNP

Foundation for Polish Science

Who can apply?

- Twinning proposals must involve a minimum of three participants
- One from a low performing MS (for example a research active university or a public or private non-profit research organisation) the applicant
- At least two internationally-leading research intensive counterparts established in at least two different Member States other than that of the applicant organisation
- Funding
 - Up to 1 M Euro (for a requested period)

Objectives:

Improve the excellence of the research and innovation landscape of promising institutions at low performing MS

Attract and maintain high quality researchers, who significantly improve research performance of an institution





ERA Chairs

• Proposal:

- Conditions for improvement, structural change in the institution
- Interaction with national or regional authorities
- Co-funding from EU structural funds
- In line with relevant strategies for smart specialization In line with ERA priorities and European Charter for Researchers and Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers



ERA Chairs



Foundation for Polish Science

Who can apply?

"research organization" (a non-profit making organization which carries out scientific or technical research as its main objective)

ERA Chairs proposals must be submitted by a single participant

Funding

- The requested EU contribution shall not exceed a maximum of EUR 2.5 million (up to 60 months)
- 90% of the total estimated budget for each proposal





Innovative Training Networks

Call publication Dec 2013
Deadline 9 Apr 2014
Options:

European Training Networks (ETN),
European Joint Doctorates (EJD)
European Industrial Doctorates (EID)

- Funding
 - 4 years, max 540 person/months (3-36 months per researcher)



European Training Networks (ETN)



Foundation for Polish Science

Objective:

intersectoral and interdisciplinary research training
 transferable skills

Proposal:

high-quality supervision arrangements
 it is strongly recommended to keep the size of the consortium between 6 and 10 beneficiaries



European Joint Doctorates (EJD)

Foundation for Polish Science

Objective:

- international, intersectoral and multi/inter-disciplinary collaboration in doctoral-level training
- at least 2 institutions conferring a joint, double or multiple doctoral degree must be established in an EU MS or AC

Proposal:

- joint governance structure
- joint doctoral programme
- transnational mobility
- at least 3 beneficiaries in different MSs or ACs (entitled to deliver doctoral degrees) + any other organisation from the same or other countries





PROJECT SKILLS (2011-2015)

Foundation for Polish Science



- Trainings:

Science management, communicating science, interdisciplinary cooperation, scientific writing, entrepreneurship, commercializing science Interdisciplinary meetings and workshops

- Mentoring Program / coaching (at least PhD holders)
- International internship (up to 6 months, for PhDs and PhD students)

– Awards for :

- interdisciplinary projects ("Inter", 100 k PLN)
- proof of concept ("Impuls", 100 k PLN)
- popularization projects for students
